

Attire is enforced as indicated in the Protocol and Traditions Manual

- Founders Day dress code determined by hostess chapter
- Chapter Activities dress code determined by hostess chapter

- ➤ Opening Ceremony-White (No pants)
- ➤ Memorial Observance -Black, Red or White (one color, no combination of colors) (No pants)
- Ecumenical-White is preferred but red, or black, business attire is acceptable.
- ➤ Rites of Passage-Black- No pants

CHAPTER MEETING ATTIRE

- > Business attire is required.
- ➤ Hats are acceptable, excluding baseball caps and paraphernalia hats.
- > Strapless tops nor spaghetti straps are considered business attire.
- > Sleeveless garments are acceptable.
- Paraphernalia jackets and line sweaters are not business attire.
- > Sweater sets/sweaters/jackets with crest are acceptable

ACCEPTABLE

- Thin straps or sleeveless outfits during the Opening Conference/Convention Ceremony with jackets/shawls (white)
- Blazers with the crest
- Sweater/sets with embossed symbols or crest.

<u>UNACCEPTABLE</u>

- "Line jackets" and paraphernalia jackets
- Garments made of denim fabric and jeans of any type or color.
- Blouses and sweaters that could be considered paraphernalia
- Pedal pushers, leggings, and capri pants

The price/brand of the garment does not make it acceptable business attire.































Flip-flops are not business attire and not permitted

















OFFICIAL DELTA SYMBOLS, INSIGNIA, COLORS & REGALIA







TERMINOLOGY

- ➤ Alumnae rhymes with "gum-tree".
- "Nationals" and "Regionals" are not Delta terms.
 ΔNational Headquarters
 ΔNational Convention and Regional Conference
- ➤No "s" on bond
- ➤ Processional a specific orderly succession of appropriate (designated) persons (Sorors, guests, officers, officials).
- ➤ Dais- raised area where designated persons are seated
- ➤ Head Table a floor level (same level) placement of appropriate persons

CYBERSPACE

- Follow Delta Internet Guidelines when posting any Delta information on chapter websites, personal websites, and social media networks.
- Any email address that identifies you as a Delta should be respectful.
- Passwords, secret motto, signs, and grip should not be written or included in email.
- Remove group email addresses before forwarding messages. Reply to Sender only.

HELPFUL HINTS

- ➤Do not put the title "Soror" on printed programs.
- ➤ Do not use "Soror" as a title on envelopes sent through the mail.
- > Jewels are never recited/printed in a public forum.
- >Proofread all written material prior to printing.
- ➤ Give away or properly dispose of unwanted items.
- ➤ When preparing your will, include a plan for a soror to properly handle your paraphernalia.
- Secrets are transmitted orally from one soror to another.
